# CHAMPIONS DAY KEN WHIGHTON Singles – MINOR Singles – MAJOR Singles


A fantastic day of finals was held at West Pennant Hills on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> April with 3 Championships played.



\$37.50, Including GST, per player. Must accompany entry form. Entries that are not accompanied by the fee will not be accepted. TO enter with payment by cheque, select the entry form located HERE

#### Entries Close:

On Line Entries must be submitted before midnight 9 May 2014.

Hard copy entries must reach the RNSWBA no later than 4.00PM on 9 May 2014.

#### Costs:

Qualifiers will receive accommodation whilst competing and lunch while competing. Qualifiers are responsible for their own transport, breakfast and evening meals.

Each Qualifier will receive some financial assistance from Bowls NSW.

#### Rules:

Sets Play, 2 Sets of 9 ends, with a 3 end tie breaker if required as per Law 15 (Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark Edition) note, shots count in tie breaker Conditions of Play available on the Bowls Australia web site (Click HERE)

Note: defeated players may be required to mark in the next round

#### Attire:

In accordance with RNSWBA Regulations & the National Dress Guidelines, Shirts & Jackets MUST have Bowls Australia logo. (Note that for National Finals all attire must also have BA logo)

For many years (from the mid 1970's-late 2000's), the the State's Hospital network conducted an annual two day Sports Tournament for its employees, incorporating about 12 sports which included Lawn Bowls.

Since the NSW Hospital Games demise (last held in 2008), I've coordinated three NSW Health Lawn Bowl Tournaments at St. John's Park Bowling Club. The **NSW Health and Ambulance Lawn Bowls Tournament** will be held on **Sunday 7th September** at **St. John's Park Bowling Club**. It is opened to employees and Volunteers on NSW Health (the Hospital network) and the Ambulance Service of NSW.

Work IDs will need to be shown, to verify Participants are employees or volunteers of the NSW Health/Ambulance network.

The Tournament is three Bowls Triples. The Format is 3 Games x 10 Ends and placings decided on most wins and margins. First placed Teams receives the Perpetual Trophy, currently held by **Concord Hospital**. Participants in top three Teams receive small Trophies and Woolworths Vouchers.

Cost is \$45 per Team - \$15 per person and includes Morning Tea and Lunch.

Teams may be male, female or mixed. The day whilst competative, is also a social day for Health Employees (who are also Bowlers) to have a social day.
