9) Treasurer

The budget for 2009/2010 has been approved by the Board of the Sports Club. The budgeted loss for the year is \$6,678 which is an improvement on last year's loss of \$12,147. A copy of the Budget is attached for your information.

The monthly budget may need to be reviewed while the annual totals can not change.

The net result for July 2009 was a loss of \$111 compared to a budget profit of \$318 and last years profit of \$406.

The major reason for the variances to budget and last year was result of cancelling 2 of the 3 Koala Carnival events.

In the last few days since being appointed as Bowls Coordinator, I have been actively involved or have given considerable thought to the following areas:-

Orange Blossom Festival

I touched base with the Hills Shire Council Events and Sponsorship Coordinator Lindal Garland, to ensure that the procurement of individual trophies for the winners or each grade is in hand. She advised that she has the matter in hand.

She also said that she had sent a message to the Mayor, Larry Bolitho, with an invitation to make presentations at the conclusion of the competition. She is still waiting to hear back from him, but will let me know if he is intending to attend or if he will delegate his duties on the day.

Major/Minor Pairs Championship

A number of the members are calling this competition "The Barry Walker Classic Pairs Competition". This has a certain ring about it and is far more appealing than "The Major/Minor Pairs Competition!

This event was originally scheduled to commence on Saturday the 10th October 2009, but due to the small number of entries in the event prior to this, i.e., the Triples, we have brought it forward to commence on the 26th September. In doing so, we will be able us to take full advantage of both greens before the bottom green is removed for annual repairs.

In addition, the definition of what is a "Major" needs to be made clear to those members intending to enter. For this competition, a "Major" is anyone who has won a Major or Minor club championship at this or any other club, or was graded 4 or 5 for the 2009 Pennant Season. Anyone who has won a novice event is still a "Minor"

The Nomination Form and Conditions of Entry, will go on the notice board on Tuesday 1st September. Entries will close on Saturday the 19th September and the 1st round will be on Saturday the 26th September 2009.

External 2010 Preseason Pennant Trials

I understand that the 2010 season may start a lot earlier than was the case this year. We need to consider how many external trials need to be arranged. In the past there have been too few, therefore I would suggest at least three, maybe even four for the two top grades and two or three for the 7's. During the probable timing of the trials, we are likely

to have just one green in action, therefore it is likely that we will only be able to host one grade at a time at home.

This matter can be discussed further at the 1st September meeting.

The interim quorum of the Match Committee met on Wednesday, 26 August 2009 to decide the course of action required relating to one member receiving dispensation in their second round triples game scheduled to be held on Saturday 29 August. After discussions pertaining to the laws and conditions of play and being mindful that the committee would not wish to hinder the member representing the club at another event, the committee asked whether all parties would be willing to play the game on Friday 4 September. The playing of the game on this day will avoid calendar difficulties. All parties have agreed this will be suitable. The interim quorum of the Match Committee is of the belief, the laws and conditions of play need to be applied accordingly while exercising leniency when necessary.
