MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING Business Papers 5th December 2011 Meeting Commences 6:00pm

1. Reports

1.1 President

November has thrown up a number of challenges, which have been dealt with or are in the process of being dealt by members of the Committee. Chief among those is the new uniforms. Warren has taken responsibility of this task and I wish to thank him for the effort he is putting into the matter. He will be issuing a separate report on the latest position.

Unfortunately, Bill Austin decided to withdraw his sponsorship of the shirts. Bill withdrew for reasons of his own, however those reasons had nothing to do with the Men's or Ladies Bowling Sections. I have written to Bill to thank him for his support over the years and it is hoped that he will continue to sponsor the Bowling Sections in the future on other ventures.

Richard Hickey is now the sole sponsor on the shirts. On behalf of the Men's Bowling Section, I have issued a thank you to Richard and look forward to a long and lasting relationship. Richard is very supportive of both Bowling Sections, therefore it is fitting that his business be advertised on the back and sleeve of the shirts.

In relation to sponsorship, Steve Watson and I had a meeting with Keryn recently to sort out the sponsorship records. Steve will have more to say on the subject in his report. In essence, we have a better understanding of what is taking place and the steps we need to take to attract sponsorship.

Following our last meeting, the holding of an open day was discussed with Max Walters. West Pennant Hills has not held an open day for many years. The demographics of the area have changed a lot in this time. The RNSWBA has a lot of material that can assist clubs in running open days. A meeting has been arranged for Wednesday 1 February 2012 with representatives of RNSWBA. As one of the committee pointed out recently, he is of the opinion one of the reasons why we do not receive strong support for our championships is due to the age of our members. This in part is correct. We need to attract younger members. We also need to support Max with his Twilight Bowls. This is also an area where new members may be found.

As you will be aware some bowlers have departed WPH to play bowls elsewhere. There has been some criticism directed at me for what has taken place. Of those bowlers who have actually left there are only four. Another two have left as they have moved to the Central Coast. Another unfortunately is unable to play due to ill health. Of the balance, WPH is still the primary club except for one who will be a social member. Shortly an announcement will be made concerning a new additional fixture to our playing calendar for 2012 and beyond. If the fixture proves to be successful it leaves the door open to expand.

I would like to add a special thank you to Mal Horner and Dallas Palm. Both were members of the previous committee and have continued to be members of the current committee. The positions they hold link the club together and both have been sounding boards for ideas and advise plus pulling me down from the pedestal from time to time. To all of the committee your support is very much appreciated.

As this will be the last report prior to Christmas and the New Year, I would like to extend my wishes to all of you and your families for a very Merry Christmas and I hope a rewarding and prosperous New Year. Eat well, drink in moderation, relax and enjoy yourselves.

1.2 Senior Vice President

Following the last committee meeting I have assumed responsibility with Peter Eagle for our new uniforms. It has been an interesting exercise, to say the least, as many things were not included in the initial quotation and the whole sponsorship matter has been difficult to resolve. Following is a summary of events and where we are up to at the time of writing the report.

- We contacted Hunter Bowls to find out when the sample shirt would be available.
- We then picked up the sample shirt and brought it to the club to show Jason Read and the bowlers.
- We also obtained a copy of the quote for a detailed review to ensure it matched our needs.
- We were advised that it would be 4 weeks from the time we place the order to receipt of the shirts. On this basis we should receive the new shirts by mid-January latest.
- We were surprised to see a very large sponsor sign on the back of the shirt for Homeway (Bill Austin) and were advised that Bill would pay \$1,000.00 (including GST or not) for the sign.
- Richard Hickey also saw the sign on the shirt and asked why he was not included as he sees himself as a co-sponsor of the Bowling Section.
- There were a lot of discussions with both Bill and Richard to resolve this matter of one sponsor or two sponsors. In the end we have only one sponsor which will be Richard Hickey.
- Richard will have one large sign on the back of the shirt and one smaller sign on the sleeve.
- Richard has committed to pay \$8.00 plus GST for every shirt ordered both now and into the future. Our initial sponsorship will be \$1,280.00 plus GST. Naturally we will get more income when we place any additional orders.
- We soon discovered that the sample cap and jacket had not been ordered. We have now placed the order and should have the samples any day now.
- Once we approve the cap and jacket we can move forward and order the caps (minimum 150 to be ordered). We will then arrange for sample jackets for members

to try on and then place the order. We will not carry stock in the jackets and they will only be ordered for those who want them.

- The quote did not include a long sleeve shirt with a wrist band. This has now been corrected.
- We picked up a full set of sample sizes and asked as many members as possible to try on the shirts. This has not been easy due to the weather and the fact that we could only keep the samples for 10 days.
- We have recorded all the orders placed by members and added quite a few for stock so that those who did not try on the shirts will be able to get one in their size. Additional orders can be placed if needed although there is a minimum of 10 for each long and short sleeve shirt irrespective of the size.
- We approval from Richard Hickey on the artwork. We are just awaiting approval from Jason Read along with the official order and deposit.
- We will be ordering 116 short sleeve shirts and 44 long sleeve shirts later this week. The total value of this order will be \$7,057.60 including GST. The club will need to pay a deposit of \$2,057.28 as per the terms of the quote.

Following is a summary of the purchase prices by item:

- Short Sleeve Shirt \$39.00 plus GST
- Long Sleeve Shirt \$43.00 plus GST
- Caps \$18.00 plus GST
- Jackets \$77.28 plus GST
- The Sports Club is providing a 50% subsidy on all items and Richard Hickey is sponsoring each shirt ordered with \$8.00 plus GST.
- We propose to give a free cap to any bowler who buys a shirt. Only one cap per member.

We are proposing the following prices for members:

- Short Sleeve Shirt \$15.00 incl GST
- Long Sleeve Shirt \$18.00 incl GST
- Caps \$10.00 incl GST
- Jackets \$45.00 incl GST
- These prices give us a small profit (around \$2.25 on average per item sold) which will help pay for the free caps. I will table a full financial analysis at the committee meeting.

As previously advised I have raised the question of more lockers and larger or additional locker room with Richard Hickey and received a positive response. I will follow this up with Richard once I have a better idea of how many lockers we need to cater for the regular men and women bowlers.

Novice Singles

The 2011 Novice Singles was won by David Roles. This was a great match and both David and Michael Dalgairns are to be congratulated for the great skills they both displayed.

This year there were just five entries received for this event and in an effort to get more players involved, I'm suggesting we expand the eligibility to read **"any player who has not won an event (i.e. Major, Minor, Novice, Barry Walker Classic Pairs or Mixed Championship) at this or any other club"**

Presently this event has a limitation of entry of four (4) years membership to the Royal and has been a major factor poor nomination numbers.

At the last meeting it was suggested that if the event is opened as suggested above, then we can't continue to call it the Novice Singles. That statement isn't valid, however if it's to be changed I would suggest we call it after the winner of the 1st Novice Singles, i.e. **"The Ken Wighton Singles"**

Mixed Pairs

We finally received eight (8) entries for this event, however owing to weather conditions we are now two weeks behind schedule and have been forced to play deferred matches on Tuesdays and Thursdays in order to get the competition back on track. The Ladies have been cooperating by allowing us to have a couple of rinks on their social days.

Carnivals

The Turn Around Triples for 2012 have all now been set and can be seen on the Events Calendar.

The Koala dates have been confirmed as, Ladies Day the 30th April and Men's Day the 4th May 2012.

Forward planning for these three events will begin in earnest immediately after Christmas.

1.7 Selectors

- We finalised the collection of pennant acceptance forms on 19/11/2011.
- We have 43 players for pennants and 7 reserves (these are players who are happy to play if available or needed). See attached list of Players
- On the basis of the above numbers we recommend that we again enter 3 teams in the 2012 Pennant Season.
- Considering the players available we also recommend we enter teams in Grades 3, 5 and 6. These are same grades as last year.
- Consistent with our Selection Policy we have nominated various selectors to meet with skips after each round to discuss the performances.
 - Grade 3 Alan Bowry and Neville Roach.
 - Grade 5 Michael Schwarcz and Warren Phillips.
 - Grade 6 Kevin Tuckerman. and Neville Roach.
- We will match up leads, seconds, thirds and skips over the coming weeks and monitor performances. We will do this with 2 Bowl Triples or Fours depending on numbers etc.
- We will not be selecting teams for the trials until mid-January.
- Our first round selections for Pennants will be held constant for the first 3 weeks unless we have availability issues.
- We have reviewed all the 16 drills and have decided three should be allocated to each of the team positions as follows:

<u>Bottom Green</u>: Due to the recent wet weather maintenance is behind by one week. It was intended to have a further rub in, however if the weather remains kind it will occur towards the end of November.

The green is being cut regularly and it has been sprayed for black spot. The grass growth over the plugs is proceeding well and with a few warm nights and regular watering, the green should come up well for the 2012 season. Prior to the green coming back into commission, it will be sprayed for nematodes, which hopefully will eliminate the problems that occurred during the course of this year. It is planned to have the green back in play by mid to late December.

<u>Top Green</u>: Maintenance has started on the top green. Some plugging will be taking place. By taking this action now it will limit the time the green will be out of action.

Although, the standard of the green is not good it is in a lot better condition than what it was before it was taken out for maintenance last year. Last year the green was taken out first. Again, subject to weather conditions it is planned to have the green back prior to the commencement of the pennant season.

The defective sprinkler heads on the bottom and top greens have been repaired. All heads are operating correctly.

No new students since last meeting. Warren Phillips has indicated he is prepared to undertake the coaching course in 2012. We are looking for others willing to take on this important role within the club, bearing in mind that Keith and Ken have advised they will not renew their qualifications in 2012.
