6.6. Saturday Social Bowls.

Discussion held around risk of non-pennant players going to other clubs during Pennant season and not returning to WPH. Previous 2 years have held the Joe Bedford Cup for non-pennant players during pennant season, however with 4 sides in pennants there have been very few social bowlers. Agreed to hold "President's Cup" competition for 8 week period following pennants. Players will receive points for playing and for wining matches both social and club championship during that period.
