4. Reports

4.1 President

The Open Day has now been held. We had eighty people attend the club on the day and forty people recorded their name for further contact. This is now well underway with appointments being made with the coaches. If we get half of those people to join then it can be claimed that the Open Day has been a success.

I would like to thank all the members who supported the Open Day, delivering flyers, the BBQ, the Introductory Coaches and Coaches, the volunteers who attended on the day both men and ladies as well as the support that WPH received from the RNSWBA. The Sports Club for their support who also picked up new members. In essence, WPH benefited from the event. Max Walters needs to be especially mentioned for the dedication that he put into the Open Day. Nothing was a bother and everything was in place on the day.





Now that we have had our first Open Day in five years, I am going to suggest that WPH hold the event every second year. We need to keep in contact with the community. The number of comments made by those attending that were not aware of the clubs location was enlightening. A number of suggestions have been made to Max to be recorded.

During October, the Men's Bowling Section underwent a Club Health Check, which was conducted by Chris Green from the RNSWBA. Dallas and I were in attendance. Our overall score was 80%. In some areas we scored 100% or in the 80% to 90% range. We achieved a reasonable score in the Members section but a less than a satisfactory score in Membership Services. The Members section has been addressed with the Open Day and Dallas is looking at ways to have greater membership participation. A number of suggestions were made by Chris. Dallas will provide more details in due course. At our Committee meeting, I will be suggesting a copy be supplied to the Sports Club.

Congratulations must go to the Major Triples winners, Dallas Palm, Ross Smith and Geoff McIntosh. It was a close game at the start, however the experience of the team started to show during the course of the game and a good win was achieved.

The Pennant season commences in February 2013. Trial games have been arranged. Kevin Tuckerman is in the process of having Pennant forms completed. It would be appreciated that assistance be provided to Kevin as this is his first year as Head Selector which is a challenging task.

The note, that is to be attached to the 2013 Annual Subscriptions concerning the Motion that was passed at the AGM has been completed and sent to Jason Read who will attend accordingly.

Plans for Presentation Day which is being held on 1 December and the Xmas Party on 16 December are underway. More details will be provided in due course.

4.9 Zone 10

There is nothing to report at this stage. It was agreed at the Zone meeting in September 2012, that Zone meetings will be take place bi-monthly. The next meeting will be in December 2012. If any matter arises that requires reporting prior to our Committee meeting it will be raised at that time.

4.10 Greens

On 15 October 2012, the bottom green was taken out for maintenance. The program is proceeding well and provided the weather is kind it is envisaged the green will be available by mid December or earlier. One rub in has taken place and it is proposed the second one will take place in the first or second week of November. A small amount of plugging may be necessary in the North West corner, however the balance of the green will not require any plugging this year.

The top green will be taken out as soon as the bottom green is available. Plugging will be necessary in the North West and South West corners. As with the bottom green there is not a lot of maintenance required.

An approach has been made to Hornsby Council to see if we can obtain some relief from the gum trees on the Western side. Due to the size of the trees there is concern that somebody may be injured by falling branches when strong winds are blowing from the Western quarter. We also have the continuing problem of leaves, and gum nuts.

An inspection of the shade cloths on both greens has been completed. Apart from some minor repairs to the cloths on the top green, there are not many problems and they will be rectified by the green keeper. In the case of the bottom green, the majority of cloths need attention. Six need replacement as the cloth has separated from the roller. With the others, there are holes in the cloth where the cloth is attached to the clips. This can be rectified by moving the clips. The green keeper can complete some of the work but the rest will require outside assistance. A full report has been supplied to Steve Brady.





The matter of the shade cloths being left up after the Ladies have completed play has been raised. After discussion with Jason Read it has been agreed, the Ladies will advise the Duty Manager after play has finished for the Duty Manager to arrange for the shade cloths to be taken down. I would like to thank Betty Gough, the Ladies President for her support.

Missed out on fatboy – green keeper was not informed of decision of WPHSC board to proceed with purchase.

Geoff McIntosh suggested approach be made to WPHSC board to get approval to convert No2 green to tiff dwarf – only takes ~6 weeks which is the same as regular renovation. Cost estimated to be ~\$5000 with grass available free from Hills BC. Tiff dwarf on top green would increase the usability of the green (less affected by shade from gum trees), and would help improve our appeal to other bowlers. Agreed to put request to club.

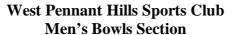

People that wish to continue have been allocated a coach to look after them.

Coaching started on the 30/10/2012 and will continue over the next few months.

There is a predominance of bowlers who wish their initial coaching on Thursdays. We need the management committee to inform the bowlers there are only 3 rinks for them to roll up on a first come first served basis, and can they please understand the needs for the use of the rinks. As soon as we can we will issue a roster of use of the rinks.

We must remember that we also have bowlers that want remedial coaching so we also need to be aware of those bowlers.

It is obvious to me that we need more coaches, with the possible non-reaccreditation of two coaches we have 6 introductory coaches, and it might be an idea if they were to buddy with one of the coaches with the idea that they eventually become coaches. We may need to fast track some new coaches. If we go down this line I would like the selection to be done by an interview process, it is now become quite costly to put someone through accreditation for Club Coach, Secretary Module, and Competition Module cost will be over \$200 per person.

I intend to have meeting with coaches and introductory coaches very shortly. Very shortly I would like to have a meeting with the Chairman of Selectors, and President with the intention to find out what is required as far pennant is concerned and other coaching requirements.





There are another 2 people looking for coaching – Dallas to coach on Sunday pm, with help from Peter Eagle.
