Zone 10 Committee AGM

4.11Greens

After recent discussions with Ross Irwin, the top green will be ready for play on Saturday 1 March 2014. This is in line with the plan that the green would be available on or around the first week in March. The weather has been on our side and Steve has put in a lot of work for this to occur. It will take around 12 months for the green to settle in properly; therefore we need to be mindful of this fact. For the first few weeks, we may have to limit roll ups. Ross has suggested that roll ups should be considered on a day by day basis especially if there has been rain. At this stage he would not like to see twilight bowls being held on the green. The surface of the green will be soft for a few weeks but with constant rolling it will firm up and improve. Dents and scuffing need to be minimised so repair work is not required, therefore the throwing of bowls from the bank onto the green or the dropping of bowls whilst on the green should not take place. If bowlers are seen doing this it needs to be brought to their attention.

The bottom green will remain in play for a few days after the top green is ready. This will allow Ross and Steve to judge that problems have not arisen that require immediate attention on the top green. Once they are satisfied and the weather conditions are favourable, the bottom green will be taken out of play for approximately 7 to 10 days. It will receive a light rub in and some maintenance requirements. The green will be back in play prior to the commencement of the Pennant season.

The shades on the Northern side of the bottom green have been replaced. This was the last set of shades that required replacement. I would like to thank the Sports Club for the support and assistance they have provided. I have been advised that the shades will last 10 years provided they are looked after and taken down when not required.

Two new Falcons have been purchased to deter birds from landing on the greens. Ross will arrange with Jason for the Falcons to be installed. It requires a few people to be in attendance during the installation process. As you have probably noticed, Sulphur Crested Cockatoos have taken up residence around the Sports Club recently. They have attacked the greens as well as the tennis courts and cricket nets. Hopefully the Falcons will deter further attacks on the greens.
