3.4 Match Committee

A couple rounds left in the Barry Walker Classic Pairs and the competitions for the 2015 are finished. I must say it wasn't an easy year to complete and allowing request for dispensations and delaying rounds of the competition made it difficult to complete on time.

It is extremely important next year that dates are set and not changed (unless absolutely necessary). It is imperative that the condition of play is adhered to.

3.5 Competition Panel

It was noted that the number of sides and players in those sides for the 2016 Pennant season have to be sent into Zone 10 by January 13, so that they can be vetted and processed before being sent to the Royal by January 30th.

Extract from State Conditions of play

4.3.1. Club Grades - Players Eligibility Clubs shall be allocated grades in accordance with Condition of Play 4.15. Clubs shall submit (by the due date) a list of all players indicated as playing with their club in that season. Only players nominated on that list shall be eligible to play for that club in the season. Players may be added with permission from the State Match Committee (through District and Zone, as applicable).

After discussion, the Selection Panel recommends that WPH enters three (3) sides and that we request the sides be entered in Grades 5, 6, and 7.

We request that the Management Committee endorse these recommendations.

Once these recommendations are endorsed, the Panel will set about selecting the best teams for each grade.

We have arranged a trial with The Hills club for grades 5,6 and 7 on the 30th January more details to come on these trials.

It is intended to contact Greenlees Park to arrange a trial with them. We also will enter in the state fours teams in both state and reserves championships.

3.6 Greens

The bottom green will receive its second rub in the week commencing 7 December. Prior to the rub in, the green will be fertilised and well watered. The green has been scarified and cored and is coming on well. There is an uneven colouring of the green but that is nothing to be concerned about. The fertilising and second rub in will rectify the situation. It is expected to have the green back in play from mid to late December. An exact date has not been set at this stage.

As soon as the bottom green is back in play, renovation of the top green will commence. As bowlers would have noticed or should have noticed, the green is showing signs of wear, however provided the green is well rolled prior to the commencement of play, it is running quite well. Considering the green has received little maintenance over the last two years, it has held up well, actually better than expected. Steve is trying to stay out of the worn areas as much as possible as well as turn the green as often as possible. Unfortunately, weather conditions which cause the gum trees to shed material across the green are a continual problem.

Thank you to Max Walters who dealt with the score boards. The areas have been painted and are ready for use.

With the hedges along the back fence, both top and bottom greens, the Committee needs to note that a request to have them trimmed should be sent to the management of the Sport Club every March. By having the hedges trimmed each year helps to increase sunlight into the corners of the greens, especially the bottom green during winter. There was a marked improvement in the corners when the hedges were trimmed this year.

Now that summer has arrived, it is important that we apply the weather policy of the club. So far this year it has been necessary to close the top green twice due to heat and gum tree material across the green. The top green is isolated and should a person be up there on their own and something was to happen, that person could be there for a considerable period of time. The argument that common sense should prevail applies, however there is a duty of care. The matter has been raised with the President of the men's bowling section under a separate email as technically this is not a greens concern, suffice to say there is a weather chart on the notice board and underneath it how the thermometer we have should be used. Placing it under shade cloth is not sufficient.

As this will be last report for 2015, may the Committee members as well as the members of the both bowling sections have a Merry Christmas and that 2016 will be a rewarding year for all the bowlers at WPH.
