3.1 President

It was agreed to submit sides in 1 in Grade 5 and 2 in Grade 6.

3.5 Competition Panel

Pennant Trial games have been organized on the following dates:

23rd January - Rosehill - Grade 5

30th January - The Hills - Grades 5, 6 and 7

6th February – Greenlees Park Grades 5, 6 and 7

5th March - West Pymble - Grades 5, 6 and 7

We have 41 players that are available to Play pennants and 10 reserves. This means we will be able to go with 3 teams. Notable omissions will be Michael Quinlan, Kevin Ross, Kevin Hoffman Jeremy Thiedeman, Jeff Campion, Norman Jackson.

Trial teams for 23rd and 30th have been selected and on the Board.

It is intended to select teams to play in the State and Reserve Fours on the 13th February. I would envisage we will have three teams in the State and three teams in the Reserve fours.

3.6 Greens

It is expected to have the bottom green back in play on Wednesday 6 January. Unfortunately, the weather forecast is indicating that rain is predicted during that week which may delay this taking place. Steve is cutting the green and rolling it as much possible. As the green is still a little spongy in places, he has added weights to the roller to harden the surface. If the green does come in on Wednesday, the top green will remain open until Friday 8 January. The bottom green will not be available on Thursday 7 January, therefore twilight bowls as well as roll ups will be on the top green only.

The rinks on the bottom green will be numbered 1 to 7 in both directions. The score boards will be placed on the northern and eastern sides of the green. The green will able to be turned especially during all day competitions without difficulties.

The top green will be taken out on or around 8 January subject to weather conditions. The green will be scarified, cored, plugged and top dressed. The two western side corners will be looked at to see what can be done to rectify the problems. Some plugging has taken place which has been noticed by bowlers when the bowl or jack bounces. Steve has tried to keep the surface as flat as possible but it has been necessary to plug now rather than later. It has also been suggested to Steve that the southern bank be top dressed. The surface is uneven and some bowlers have complained. There is nothing that can be done to the southern bank of the bottom green until the Sports Club deals with the water overflow when it rains and the air conditioning unit.

There has been a suggestion that contact be made with Hornsby Council to see if further trimming of the gum trees can take place on the western side. The request has to come from the Sports Club. I am suggesting that when Jason Read returns from holidays a request be made to him to see if he is prepared to write to Council. I am happy to deal with this issue as I was involved when the last trimming took place.

Cliff Johnston is in the process of completing the bowl and jack markers for the top green. They are slightly smaller than the current ones but they can be seen. Cliff will commence the re-furbishing to the old rink numbers on the top green as soon as it comes out. The numbers will be 8 to 14 both sides

All the preliminary requirement pertaining to the greens have been completed.
