# 3.6 Greens

The top green by the time this report is read by the Committee will be back in play. The playing surface has recovered better than expected as the weather conditions have been in our favour. Plugging has taken place in the south/west corner and plugging will commence in the north/west corner and along some edges as soon as the plugs are available. Ross Irwin is of the opinion that although the plugging will take place a little later than expected, there is sufficient time for growth before winter takes hold. Currently, even without the plugging, seven rinks can be accommodated running north/south.

The gum trees are still a major factor. The management of the Sports Club have advised that Hornsby Council have acknowledged the application for the trees to be inspected, however a date has not been advised. The issue has been discussed with Bob Cole. If nothing has eventuated within a week or so, there is another avenue that can be used. Bob has advised, that the Sports Club will not have any objection for a representative of the bowling section to be in attendance at the time of the inspection. If we can get the trees trimmed etc, the sooner the better.

On the subject of trimming, we are now into March and the hedges at the back and sides of the greens need addressing. As the Committee is aware; the hedges need to be trimmed if we are to

avoid wet corners during winter. The weather forecast for Autumn is indicating that we may be in for a wet period. May I suggest a follow up note be sent to the management of the Sport Club. I will leave this in your hands.

The bottom green is performing well, probably a little better than expected at this time of the year. The feedback from clubs that have played on the green has been very positive.

As mentioned in my last report, consideration is being given to purchasing a set of new score boards. This will allow both greens to be accommodated without having to move the score boards when a green or greens are turned. With the assistance of Bob Cole, a number of options have been considered and it is felt that we may be in a position to seek approval from the Sports Club. The score boards are not cheap. Some of the numbers on the current boards are also rusting. In looking around, we may have come across a second hand Big Board. It will require some work being completed on it but it will be easier to handle than some of the boards that we have.

We now have a complete set of rink numbers for the top green. One set are new, whilst the other set have been re-furbished by Cliff Johnstone. We also have sufficient rink pegs for all sides of both greens. They are all yellow with white caps. The new windsocks will be installed prior to the commencement of the pennant season.

Peter Eagle Noted by committee that top green is playing well. Still dirt at park end. How do we get full 14 rinks available for TAT & Koala? Council still to advise about trimming of trees. Hedge trimming. Score boards are due shortly. Jack & bowl markers missing?
