REPORT ON WPH MIXED SOCIAL BOWLS DAY HELD ON MONDAY 6TH OCTOBER 2014

Report regarding a problem with the BBQ area during the running of the Mixed Social Bowls Day on Monday 6th October 2014

I had discovered that there were no gas bottles in the BBQ area on Sunday 5/10/14 and after approaching the Club Duty Officer, Andrew, he arranged for a bottle to be in place in readiness for the Monday morning. When David and Denise tried to start the BBQ to begin cooking it was discovered that the gas had what was thought to be a leak at the bottle or copper pipe connection above. The problem was finally discovered to be that the main copper pipes at the base of the 2x hot plates had been cut off. The Club duty officer was approached and arrangements were made with the WPH Kitchen staff to cook the sausages and onions in the kitchen oven. All turned out OK with the Bowlers being fed around 1pm.

I was originally planning on sending a formal letter to the WPH Sports Club to notify them of this incident and our dissatisfaction in that we had requested the BBQ to be available at the time of booking the Function area on 18/9/14, however, on Friday 10/10/14, I was approached directly by the Club CEO, Jason Read, who offered his apologies for the problem. Subsequently, following discussion with Peter Eagle and Michael Schwarcz, I am only tabling this incident in this report with no formal report going to the WPH Sports Club. It is also noted that Jason has informed me that the BBQ area is no longer available and that no new BBQ facilities are proposed for the area on completion of the new building works. This will need to be further discussed as this will affect the catering for any future events such as a proposed Mixed Social Bowls Day on Australia Day 26/1/15.
