THE JOE BEDFORD TROPHY

In the early 1970's the newly established West Pennant Hills Men's Bowling Club was developing rather slowly from a small initial membership base. Keith Walkom, Foundation President of the licensed club, maintained a keen interest in all the club sports sections of the club. Concerned about the relatively slow development of the Men's Bowling club, but a non bowler at that time, Keith donated a trophy with the objective of encouraging regular participation in the game of bowls by bowling club members.

Joe Bedford was secretary of the Formation Committee of the proposed club in 1966-67. Following the Foundation Meeting on 12 December 1967 Joe was elected the first secretary of the incorporated club then known as the West Pennant Hills Bowling and Recreation Club Limited. Joe resigned from this position in 1969 due to failing health.

In recognition of the then late Joe Bedford's contribution to the club as the first secretary of the club this trophy was named the Joe Bedford Trophy.

An Early History Of The Club And The Formation Of The Men's And Women's Bowling Clubs (1967-71) - Part Two

Foundation Meeting - 12th December, 1967

Prior to this historic meeting several public type meetings were staged with the objective of generating community interest in the proposed Club. The meetings were publicised by letter box drop, direct mail outs and local newspapers. These meetings attracted between 60 and 100 people, most of the meetings were attended by the then Shire President, some Councillors and the late Max Ruddock, M.L.A., the Member for The Hills Electorate, who was an enthusiastic supporter of the proposed Club.

The Foundation Meeting held at the Pennant Hills High School was attended by 244 people, 185 male and 59 female prospective members. All in attendance personally signed the Memorandum and Articles of Association as subscribers to the document and became Foundation Members of the proposed Club. Less than 30 of the original 244 Foundation Members remain as members of the registered club and include only 8 current members of our two bowling clubs.

The Certificate of Incorporation of the West Pennant Hills Bowling and Recreation Club Limited was issued on 16th February, 1968. Following the incorporation of the Club the then members of the Founding Committee were confirmed as the first Board of Directors of the Club at a general meeting on 8th May, 1968 –

President - Keith Walkom, Vice Presidents - Barry Amos and Wilf Morschel, Secretary - Joe Bedford, Treasurer - Jim Henderson, Board Members - Kevin Hill, Barry McGlasson, Ken McWhirter, Frank Nock, Dick Stokes and Frank Yardley.
