MATCH COMMITTEE UPDATE - MAL HORNER

Changes to Commencement Times

The current Daylight Savings Time will end on Sunday 5th April 2009. It is proposed that from that date until the recommencement of Daylight Savings on Sunday the 4th October 2009, the starting time for social bowls on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturday's will be bought forward ½ an hour to 12:30pm.

The purpose of this change is to enable matches to be finalised whilst playing conditions are still favourable.

The normal phone-in time of 11:00am to 12:00 noon will also be brought forward $\frac{1}{2}$ an hour and will operate from 10:30am to 11:30 am.

Starting times for all club championships will be per the conditions listed on the entry forms.

Pennants will not be affected by these changes.

Changes to Nominated Pairs

Commencing on Friday the 20th March 2009, the Friday Nominated Pair's Competition in its present format will be replaced by a new competition know as the Brassiere Pair's Competition.

The Management Committee believe that Friday Bowls in the present format has become jaded. This is mainly due to a lack of competition both in numbers and match-ups. It is proposed that the Club's lady bowlers will also be invited to participate.

The new format will be based on single entries and selected teams and will be in place for a three (3) month trial period, after which time an assessment will be made to determine the better format, i.e., nominated pairs or single entries.

The Brassiere Pairs rules will be as follows:

- All players will enter as single players, just as they presently do on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- The phone will be manned to take entries between 11:00am and 12:00; Entries will close at twelve noon.
- In the event of odd numbers, the last person to enter will be asked to sit out, unless we are able to find an additional player to make the numbers even.
- If the number of entries don't allow for all pairs matches, then the last six (6) names will make-up a triples match. If still too many then the next six (6) will make-up another triples match.
- Matches will be arranged by the selectors. The winning pair will be the team with the biggest margin. In the event of a tie, a count back on the number of ends won will be applied. If still equal, the margin on the last end will determine the winning team. If still equal the margin on the second last end will be used and so on.
- The winning team members will each receive a \$25 voucher redeemable at the club Brassiere.
- If the winning team comes from a triples match, each winning member will receive a \$20 voucher, redeemable at the Brassiere.
- The name of the competition will change from Friday Nominated Pairs to the "Brassiere Pairs Competition".
